SPARE CAR DETAILS - Per Current Rule per Speedcars Australia 2010/2011 Rule Book:

7.14.8 - A driver having already qualified for a race or a Championship Final may substitute another car, forfeiting all qualifying points and starting ROF.

Spare cars may be nominated for a fee of \$100 providing they are registered with Speedcars Australia. This spare car nomination is to be completed on the competitor nomination form. This allows the nominated competitor access to the spare vehicle in the event their fully nominated car is unable to be used during competition.

If a different driver than the above nominated driver on the form is put into the nominated spare car prior to the event but after nominations close, the full late fee of \$400 will still be charged to enter the additional driver/car in the event.

Any spare cars taken to the event which are not previously nominated will be excluded. The spare car must complete and meet scrutineering requirements per current procedures.

The spare car will not be included in grid draws for qualifying heats and does not entitle the registered car owner and/or driver to additional gate entry passes.

Changing cars under the above quoted rule (both own nominated spare or borrowed nominated spare) will result in the following:

Heat races:

If the spare car replaces the nominated car then the driver loses all points accrued to that point and will start ROF in the first heat driven in the spare car only, and be gridded for remaining events per the original format/draw.

Pole Shuffle:

If the spare car replaces the nominated car after heats are completed, and the driver has qualified for the pole shuffle, the driver/car will be classed as the last placed entrant in the pole shuffle line-up only and return gridded for remaining events.

Feature Races:

If the spare car replaces the nominated car after heats are completed (and the pole shuffle where applicable), the driver/car will start ROF in their qualified main event. For example, ROF in the B Main with potential to transfer to A Main grid; or ROF (24th) in the A Main if directly qualified.

These requirements will be imposed again if the driver elects to return to his original car and/or another nominated car.

IMPORTANT: In the event a competitor elects to use a spare Speedcar they must notify the Speedcar Australia Race Director prior to taking to the track for the next race. The Race Director and/or Chief Steward will determine if the existing car can be replaced with a spare car.

- 7.14.3 'Visiting International cars must conform to all Speedcars Australia rules and specifications (6.27.1).
- 7.14.4 'Exhaust systems on visiting International cars must comply with all Speedcars Australia specifications and local noise regulations (6.27.2).
- 7.14.5 'International Drivers and Cars must be affiliated with Speedcars Australia before competing (6.27.3).
- 7.14.6 'Any driver can qualify, in any Speedcars Australia sanctioned car in a National Title'.
- 7.14.7 'No two (2) drivers can qualify in the same car'.
